Eric-

The total building capacity, including all back of house spaces, stage, bars, and office, is 7420.

In the auditorium we have 3,042 fixed seats (including ADA and the orchestra removable seats) plus a standing room/loose seat capacity of 1,212. The two balconies over the stage add an additional 358 occupants. This gives us a total capacity of 4,612. If we remove the orchestra seats and make the area standing room, the total capacity becomes 4,870. These numbers do not include the Lobby, Grand Salle, or Stage. For a special event, the Lobby, Grand Salle, and Stage can also in used with added capacities of 668, 607, and 521, respectively. Include all three spaces, the total capacity is 6,666 occupants.
